## **MEXICO WINDPOWER 2014 SOARS AS NEW ENERGY REFORM OPENS MARKET**

BETHESDA, MD (March 13, 2014) – Mexico WindPower 2014 wrapped up on a high note with record attendance and soaring optimism about the state of the wind industry south of the border.

Anticipating a booming wind market in Mexico as a result of the new energy reform bill passed last December, the third edition attracted over 2,400 international wind energy professionals to the two day conference and exhibition in Mexico City. "Reform changes the respective roles of the public and private sectors in the development of Mexico's energy mix, the investment landscape for the generation, transmission and distribution, and will create opportunities for the wind industry" stated Steve Sawyer, Secretary General Global Wind Energy Council.
