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M-ENABLING LAUNCHES INAUGURAL EVENT IN RUSSIA

MOSCOW (May 20, 2015) – Within the development of business initiatives in Russia, organizers E.J. Krause & Associates and Global Initiative for Inclusive Information and Communication Technologies (G3ict), produced for the first time **M-Enabling Russia**, an international social project focused on accessible mobile information and communication technologies. The launch of **M-Enabling Russia**, a conference and showcase dedicated to promoting mobile accessibility and assistive applications and services for senior citizens and users with disabilities, was held on May 13, 2015 at the Renaissance Moscow Monarch Center Hotel.

M-Enabling Russia 2015 gained high level government support from the Ministry of Industry and Trade of the RF, the Ministry of Telecomm and Mass Communication of the RF, the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of the RF, the Informational center UNIC, the Agency for strategic initiatives, professional organizations, funds and structures.

Alex Leblois, President of G3ict, commented on the importance of the project: *“The high level and active participation of government, advocates and private sector organizations at **M-Enabling Russia** demonstrates the importance and potential for mobile technologies in Russia because of the great presence of seniors and persons with disabilities in the growing digital economy. The quality of interactive presentations and debates was exceptional for the first event of this kind, reflecting Russian expertise in information technologies and disability issues. It was also clear through the **M-Enabling** panels and experience sharing that Russian developers and companies can significantly contribute to the global marketplace. With seven billion mobile devices in use today around the world, and one billion persons with disabilities, many of whom are seniors, accessible and assistive technology solutions are in very high demand. At **M-Enabling Russia**, Russian developers and companies are well positioned to benefit from this global opportunity in which they can further explore. We are looking forward to a stronger and even larger 2016 **M-Enabling Russia**.”*

More than 200 attendees from Russia and the CIS, The United States, Brazil, Germany, and India visited **M-Enabling Russia**. The list of international and domestic participation supported the unique exchange of practices and expertise, and focused on the latest worldwide developments in the industry.

Leblois welcomed participants, delegates and guests at the opening ceremony. Influential keynote speakers included Javed Abidi of the Disabled People’s International (DPI), Dmitry Khalin, Technical Director of Microsoft Russia, and Stanislav Ivanov, Vice President of All-Russian Society of Blind.

Professionals from both industry and private sector, as well as representatives from state and disability advocacy groups participated in parallel session discussions. **M-Enabling Russia 2015** was the ideal platform to discuss the acquisition on general access to information and communication technologies, excluding discrimination based on the characteristics of disability.
