WASHINGTON, D.C., March 30, 2012 – The U.S. Department of Commerce's U.S. Commercial Service is pleased to announce that it has granted Trade Fair Certification status to E.J. Krause & Associates to host the official United States Exhibitor Pavilion at the Mexico WindPower 2013 exhibition, held January 30-31, 2013 in Mexico City, Mexico. Mexico WindPower 2013 is Mexico's largest trade event for wind power design, construction and power distribution. It is also the only wind power event in Mexico which is co-organized and supported by the Mexican Wind Energy Association (AMDEE) and the Global Wind Energy Council (GWEC). The American Wind Energy Association is also a supporting organization. In February 2012, Mexico WindPower was a successful high level conference with sponsors that generated business. Over 25 sponsors and 300 visitors were at the 2012 event. Based on this success, Mexico WindPower 2013 will be a full exhibition with the conference, including a new focus on Latin American sales.
